History Since January 2018

- Majority of the young adults live in an apartment or house.
- B2i has experienced 1 to 2 young adults per month residing in a homeless shelter.
- Variance for dorm residence combined with meals provided and no meals provided has averaged between 8-14 young adults per month.
- Host Homes have increased as the lowest number of host homes is 2 as a residence for young adults with the highest usage of 10.
- Adult Family Homes (DD) has ranged from 13 to 18.
